## Mexico

**Opened:** 1954  
**Number of children:** 806\*  
**Features:** Primary, secondary and technical schools, clinic, chapel and farm. An outreach program serves children from a garbage dump in Milpillas.

## Guatemala

**Opened:** 1996  
**Number of children:** 348  
**Features:** 25 acres of land, kinder through junior high school, computer lab, vocational workshops, clinic, gardens and a solar water heating system.

## El Salvador

**Opened:** 1999  
**Number of children:** 446  
**Features:** Houses for boys, girls and babies, clinic, school, vocational workshops, and an "open" classroom for those with no previous education.

## Nicaragua

**Opened:** 1994  
**Number of children:** 320  
**Features:** Farm, clinic, chapel, school and workshops. Due to safety issues related to volcanic activity, the main home is being relocated.

## Peru

**Opened:** 2004  
**Number of children:** 71  
**Features:** Once a hotel, the site is 1.5 hours from Lima on 3.7 acres with a pond, gardens and library. The permanent site will be in Cañete near the capital.

## Haiti

**Opened:** 1988  
**Number of children:** 829\*  
**Features:** 15 acres 5,000 feet above sea level, 19 residential cottages, an open-air amphitheater, chapel, farm and a primary school (grades 1-8).

## Dominican Republic

**Opened:** 2003  
**Number of children:** 196  
**Features:** 15 acres of land, small group houses, primary school and gardens. Can accommodate 300-500 children.


## Honduras

**Opened:** 1986  
**Number of children:** 527\*  
**Features:** Preschool through secondary schools, chapel, farm, special homes for disabled children and elderly adults, and clinics that see over 10,000 patients a year.

## Bolivia

**Opened:** 2005  
**Number of children:** 69  
**Features:** Dining hall and six homes for children and staff. There will eventually be a school, church and clinic.
