We invite you to visit Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH, Spanish for "Our Little Brothers and Sisters") Honduras with us. You will meet the amazing children, staff and volunteers of NPH and learn the ins and outs of their daily lives. If you are new to Friends of the Orphans, visiting a home is the best way to see what we do in action. If you are a longtime supporter or sponsor, come catch up with old friends and see how your Godchildren are growing and flourishing. Travelers of all ages are welcome, including children.* Join us - your life may never be the same!

**In compliance with NPH's international volunteer policy, all visitors under the age of 21 must be accompanied by an adult chaperone.*

NPH Honduras

Opened in 1986, NPH Honduras is home to 564 children, including 35 supported externally. *Rancho Santa Fe* is located one hour northeast of Tegucigalpa, the nation's capital. It features a preschool/kindergarten, primary and secondary schools, vocational workshops, clinics, chapel and a 500-acre farm. In addition, there are two special homes: *Casa de los Angeles* for disabled children, and *Casa Eva* for elderly adults who have no family to care for them. *Casa Pasionista*, a home for adults living with HIV/AIDS, is located on the Ranch property.

Trip Highlights

While the children are in school, you will help out at the ranch (preparing tortillas, gathering eggs, caring for the babies, working in the kitchen, etc.). Relax or hang out with the *pequeños* in the afternoon. In the

evenings, you will join the children for their evening meal, help them with their homework or play with them. You will have the opportunity to meet with the leadership of NPH Honduras and other NPH staff, as well as tour all of the home's facilities, including *Casa de Los Angeles*. Plus, there will be a gathering with high school/university students in Tegucigalpa.

Cost: \$400 per person

Price includes:

- Accommodations at Rancho Santa Fe
- Local transportation
- Donation to NPH through Friends of the Orphans
- Meals while at NPH
- Meal with international volunteers
- Meal with high school/university students
- Friends of the Orphans interpreter and guide

Price does not include:

- Airfare (\$600-\$800 per person)
- Outside meals

Payment Schedule

- \$250 non-refundable deposit due July 1, 2010
- \$100 due August 15, 2010

Visitors often ask what items they can bring for the children. We suggest underwear for children and teenagers, clothes, shoes, tennis shoes, school supplies, medicine and clinic supplies as these items are always needed. Please do not bring expensive gifts.
